

Homeschool Association Guidelines

In accordance with AACCS, individual homeschools may not join SSACS only homeschool associations may join. SSACS seeks to advance and build Christian Education primarily through Christian schools and homeschool organizations and is not able to accommodate individual homeschools. To this end, we have established the following criteria for homeschool associations.

1. The homeschool association must be integrally connected and under the auspices of a local church and pastor who is in agreement and signs the SSACS Statement of Faith and exclusion clause. The Homeschool Association must be registered with the state with a state number attached to its title.
2. The homeschool association must have a specific student registration signed by parent with the name, address and phone number as well as a signed (by parent) SSACS Statement of Faith (A registration fee is recommended to at least cover the cost of membership to SSACS.) The Homeschool Association needs to have records of the students' educational curriculum being used, grade level, academic progress within the curriculum used and other records consistent with a school
3. The homeschool association must have at least THREE (3) different homeschool families in membership
4. There must be ONE designated contact person (Administrator, Director, Representative etc.) who will be the only contact person for SSACS materials (competition, convention etc.) That person will issue checks for membership, competitions etc.)
5. Students may not be registered or members of other homeschool associations, schools or Christian schools NOT including dual enrollment with a college.
6. The representative of the homeschool association will attend teacher conferences, competitions etc. to represent the school association.
7. Registration to SSACS will be the same as all schools with the inclusion of a list of students, names and addresses.

It is our desire to advance the quality of Christian education and avoid confusion for competitions and SSACS events.
